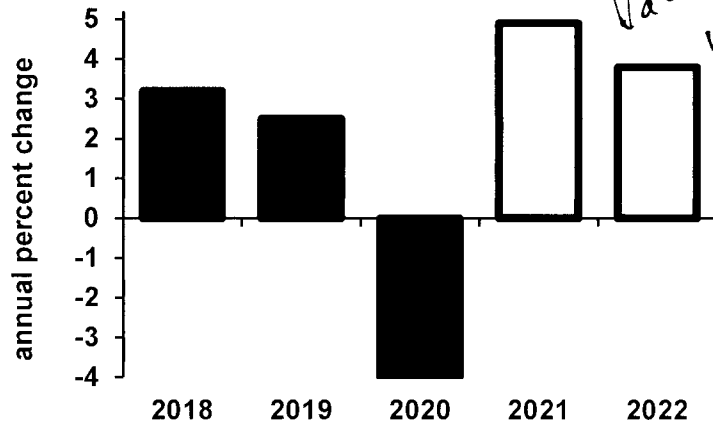
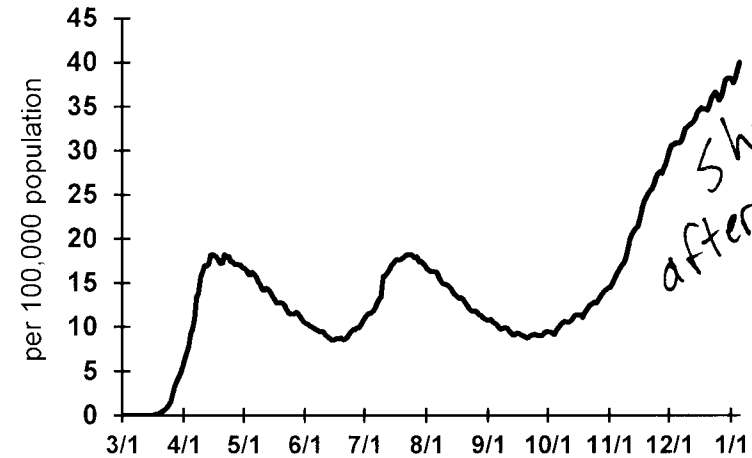

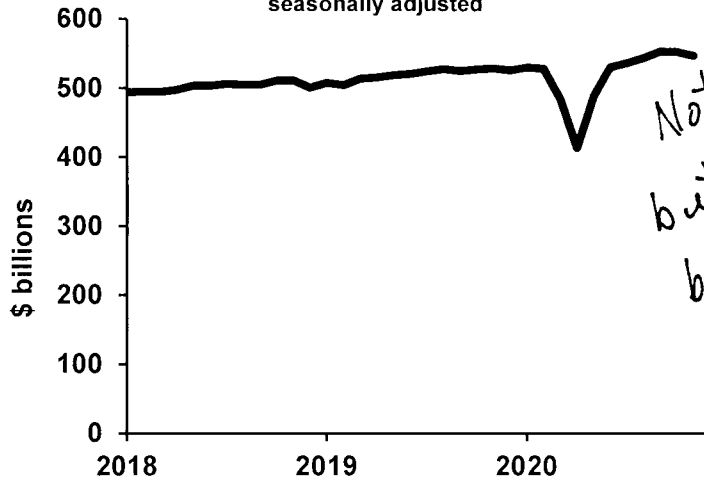

U.S.



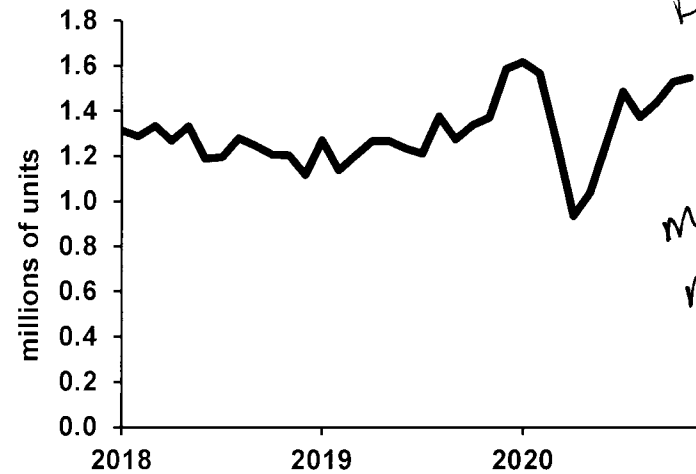

seasonally adjusted



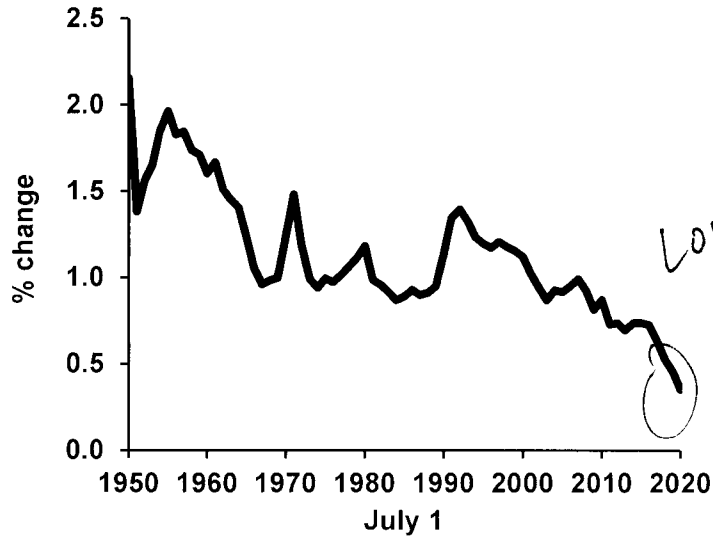

Housing Starts

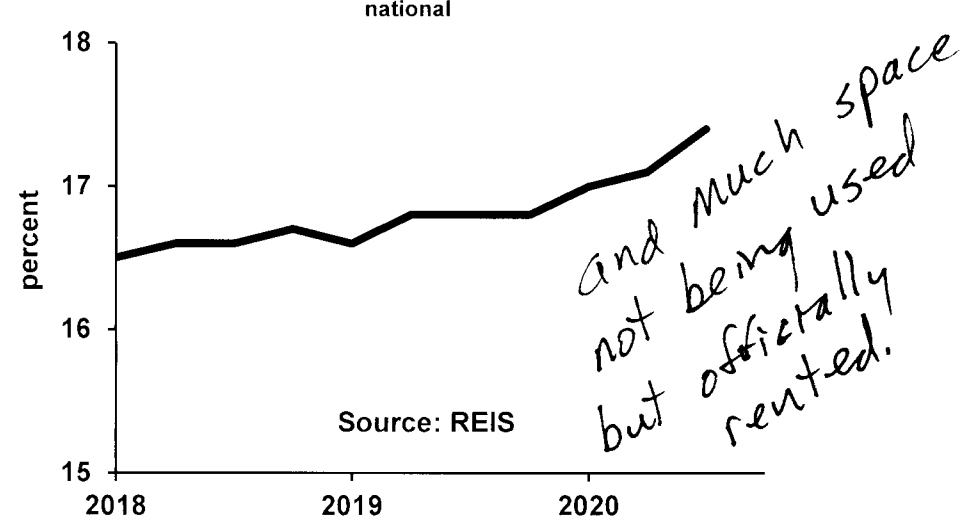

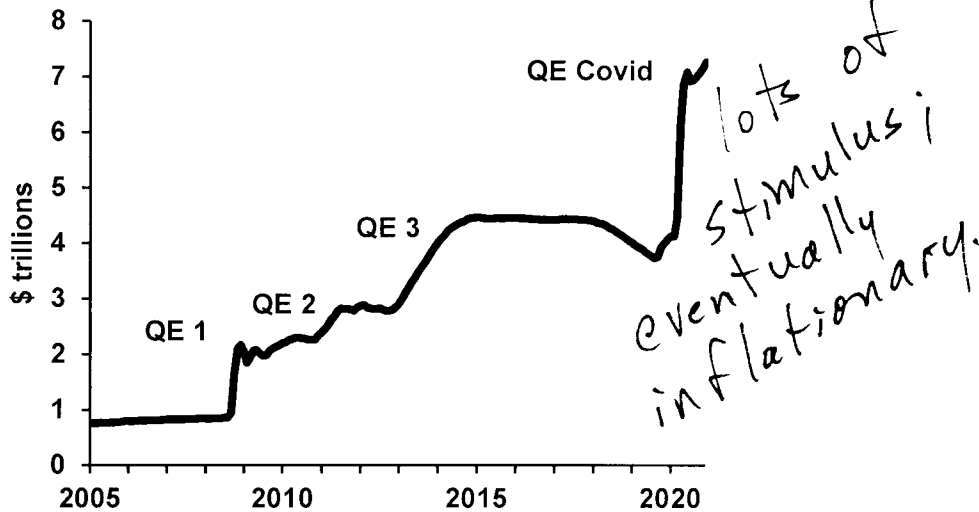
U.S. Population Growth



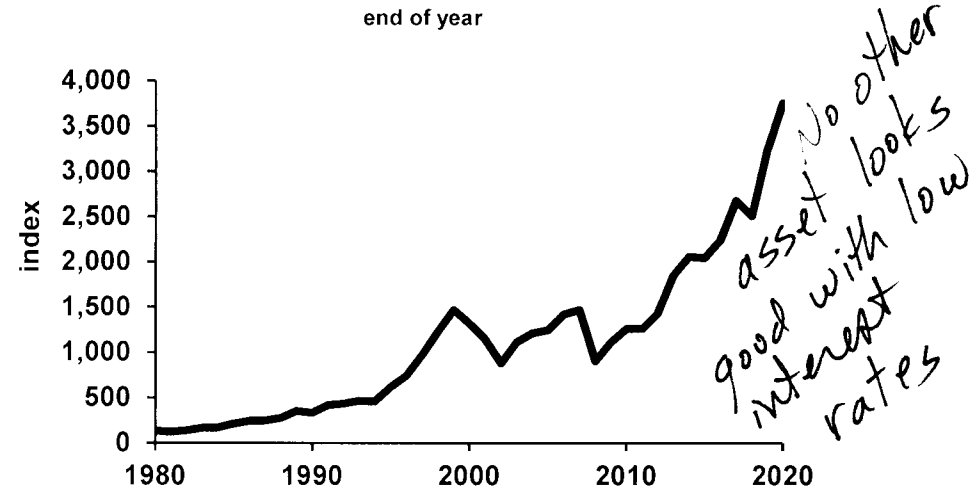
Office Vacancy



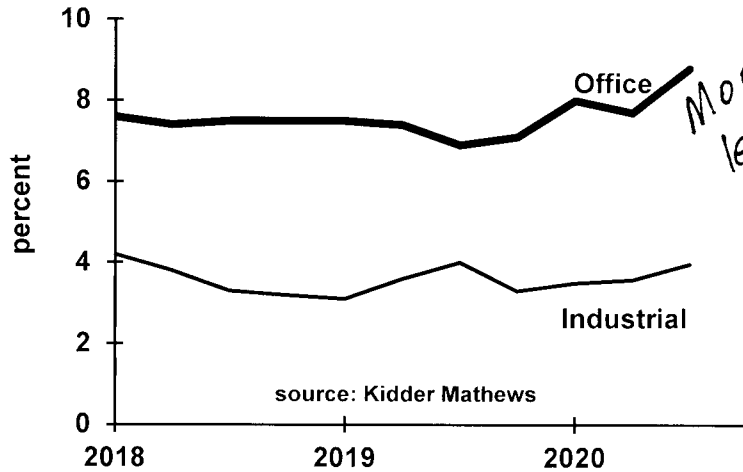
Federal Reserve Credit



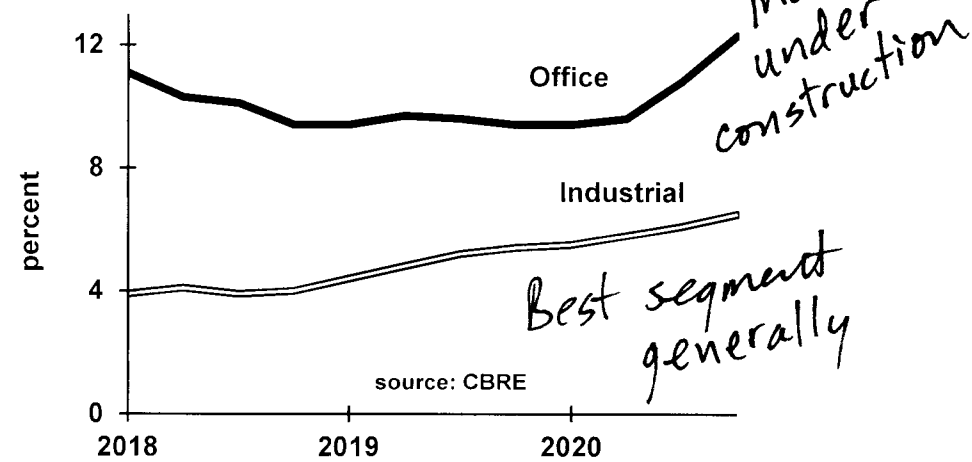
S&P 500 Stock Prices



Portland Vacancy Rates

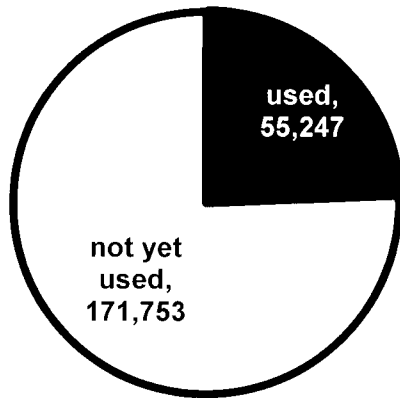


Seattle-Tacoma Vacancy Rates



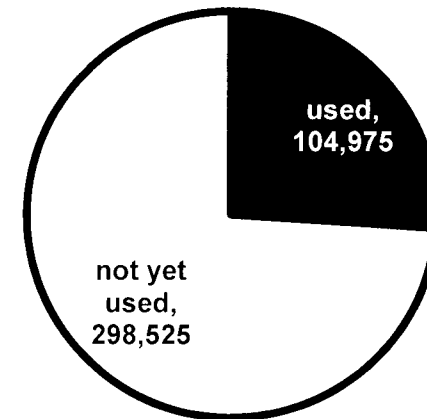
Oregon Covid Vaccinations
